## Genesee Valley Park Boathouse

In Genesee Valley Park, our boathouse is home to rowers & paddlers who enjoy the calm and smooth waters of the Genesee River and Erie Canal. Members can store their personal rowing shell, canoe, or kayak in our secure indoor facility with 24 hour access to their stored equipment.

Rowing Members have the option of paying for use of GWC sculling equipment, which is available on a first-come first-served basis. We have variety of rowing shells to accommodate different skill levels.

## Lock 32 Whitewater Park

The park lies in the spillway bed of the Erie Canal, one of the few man-made whitewater parks in the country! It was designed to provide a controlled environment in which paddlers can learn and a challenging place for experienced paddlers to practice. The course features a set of squirt lines, two wave and two holes—and most importantly, a constant source of water every day! Paddlers take advantage of this park to learn new moves and tricks, practice their skills, or just to get out and have some fun with friends on a summer evening.
